15EL1532/E APPLICATION TO REBUILD 11KV OVERHEAD LINE BETWEEN MALLTRAETH AND LLANGAFFO NO OBJECTION

45C482 FULL APPLICATION FOR THE ERECTION OF 21m HIGH LATTICE TOWER WITH ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT ON LAND NORTH EAST OF CAE GORS NEWBOROUGH OBJECTION

The reason behind this objection are the area is ecologically sensitive it has bats in the area and a bat survey is recommended as well as crested newts and red squirrels. There is a lot of local objection by the residents of this area who attended the meeting last night to voice their objections. There is the visual aspect of the mast as well as being situated at the end of a 6ft ditch and there is the water table to think about as this is a flood plan area. And would this open up the area to other companies wanting to situate their mast in this area. Cae Gorse only has a well water source and this mast is situated on the land adjacent how will this affect the well on this property.

13.1: Parking problems in Newborough : Various councillors brought up parking and traffic problems in Newborough it was agreed Councillor Peter Rogers go to see the Highways department and schedule a meeting to discuss all the various problems including the proposed yellow lines and traffic prohibitions and the speeding along the A4080 from Bryn to Newborough. And from Llangaffo to Gaerwen.

13.2 : Councillor Brian Owen agreed to go to see ACC regarding the broken recycling boxes which residents have been told if the boxes are damaged they will have to pay for new ones.

13.3: Councillor Jane Sykes reported the car park in Newborough is littered with rubbish : Resolved to write to Ehealth to report the matter.

13.4: Councillor Dennis Owen reported one of the coping stones on the railway Ty Brwyn bridge in Llangaffo is loose : Resolved to write to British Rail and Highways to report the matter. Councillor Owen reported the Village Hall in Llangaffo has been broken into and there has been vandalism to the area and a window has been broken in the church by children playing in the graveyard. The chairman agreed to speak to the rector to discuss the matter. Also Councillor Owen raised concerns about parking outside the shop in Llangaffo.

13.5: Councillor Thomas Hughes reported the hedges by the school in Newborough needed attending to and also the hedge from Tacla Taid to Newborough needs cutting back and the hedge behind Glandwr Terrace Dwyran and the Cae Coch footpath need cutting: resolved to contact the council to report these items.

13.6 : It was requested the clerk write to Dwyran farmer Mr Edmund Williams offering condolences on the death of his mother and the offer of any help due to the fire on his farm in recent weeks.
