**2: DECLARATION OF INTEREST:** No Interest Declared

**3: PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES: Decision:** Confirmed by Councillor Tim Owen and seconded by Councillor David Roberts These were accepted and signed as correct the minutes of the meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2017.

**NATURAL RESOURCES WALES :** Graham Williams for Natural Resources Wales and Peter Lloyd Harvesting Manager outlined the plans for felling of 4 hectares of pine forest at Llanddwyn to monitor the effect of the water table planned for Jan and Feb 2018 Councillor David Roberts raised the subject that the public were not happy about the prospect of the tree felling as the forest was originally planted to counter the effect of the movement of the sand dunes Councillor Dennis Owen raised a question regarding the effect of lorries traveling to and from the beach through the villages.

**4: MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES:**

**4.1 :** Letter in hand from The Highways department of Anglesey County Council regarding our request for a fence to be erected by Tre Rhosyr in Newborough outside the site of the new school. A fence cannot be erected because of the width of the pavement and it would obstruct the vision of the lorry drivers accessing the main road from the estate. They confirmed there was a Construction Phase Management plan in place for deliveries to and from site.

Mr Alun Thomas has attended and cut back the hedge as requested by councillors at last months meeting. Invoice received from Mr Alun Thomas for various work carried out during last month including maintenance of the Community Councils machinery. Resolved to write to Mr Thomas to thank him for the professional way he has conducted the maintenance of all machinery and for grass cutting and hedge cutting for the Community Council.

**13. ANY OTHER MATTERS :**

**13.1:** Various hedges and verges were reported and it was resolved to ask Anglesey County Council and A.Thomas to cut them .

**13.2 :** Concerns were raised about the fooding to the road at the junction in Dwyran by the ink bottle cottage also the large ruts left on the verge by Tal Gwynedd. Resolved to write to ACC to ask them to attend to these matters.

**13.3** It was asked of the clerk to write to the education department of ACC to enquire what will happen to the school playing field in Dwyran when the school move to Newborough in 2019.

**13.4** Hedges at the Dwyran end of the miles road still have not been cut by ACC Resolved to write again to request this be attended to as soon as possible.

**13.5** Concerns were also raised regarding the Network Rail vehicles parking on the grass verges by the Railway bridge in Llangaffo and this in turn creating a problem with mud on the road. Information was also requested regarding the weight restrictions on this bridge as there is a worry regarding large vehicles carrying building materials to and from the new school build in Newborough

**13.6** Concerns were raised about fireworks being let off by Clynnog in Dwyran Resolved to write to Menai Cottages to request they inform the tenants to refrain from letting off fireworks without good reason.

**13.7** It was requested that the clerk write to ACC to inform them of a large hole in the tarmac in the road by 6/7 Ucheldre Newborough.

**13.8** It was requested that the clerk write to Natural Resources Wales to enquire as to the number of dog Fouling waste bins the Community Council would need.
