

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF
THE RHOSYR COMMUNITY COUNCIL
HELD AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER DWYRAN SCHOOL
ON 4th JUNE 2018 AT 7.00 PM**

Cynefin: Representatives: Noella Jones, Catrin Roberts, Gwyndaf Williams. The representatives from Cynefin met with the community council to discuss the ongoing problems with the Pen y Bryn Estate in Dwyran. The Community Councillors outlined the problems: Parking problems antisocial behaviour, unfinished building work to the estate, children playing in the road. It was pointed out to Cynefin that the original planning was for 5 houses and now there are a proposed 15 affordable houses planned for the tiny estate with no outlined playing areas for the estate children and the gardens are very small therefore the children are playing in the road or in the parking ground of the Dr Surgery next door, the walls in front of the estate are being vandalized and the agreed planting of trees as in the original planning application have not been carried out. Cynefin agreed to look into the problems and the lack of response to the previous correspondence outlining the problems with this estate sent by the Community Council clerk, Gwyndaf Williams outlined the problems with the road and drains on the estate and confirmed that the two houses on the front road are due to be completed by September 2018. Catrin Roberts outlined plans to speak to existing tenants regarding antisocial behaviour.
