9: COUNTY COUNCILLOR REPORTS :

Councillor Bryan Owen confirmed that ACC are in the process of carrying out hedge cutting works all over
Anglesey and the hedges in the Rhosyr ward will be attended to soon, and that the bridges in Llangaffo and
Dwyran have been tested for the weight restrictions by Highways and are within the safe required restriction
limit. Councillor Rogers enquired about the old noticeboard in Dwyran and it was agreed to get quotes for a
new notice board for Llangaffo due to the old one being damaged beyond repair. Councillor Rogers
expressed concern regarding the delay with the new school build in Newborough.

13.2. A new handrail is required on the Llwyn Ysgaw stile in Dwyran : Resolved to request a new one from Anglesey County Council.

13.3. Councillor Sykes enquired as to why the 40pmh speed limit was restricted to a small section of the A4080 in Dwyran : Resolved to ask Highways why this speed limit was not extended to the whole section of the A4080 in Dwyran. A speed camera was requested to be placed on this stretch of road as vehicles were not observing the new speed limit : Resolved to request this from Highways and North Wales Police.

13.4 A request was made to have warning signs for speeding tractors and lorries on the Pen y Bont bridge and road in Dwyran.Resolved : to request signs from Anglesey County Council.

13.5 Complaints were made regarding no toilet facilities on the mermaid road and the tourists were urinating in the fields along this road. Resolved to write to Anglesey County Council to enquire about some toilet facilities.

13.6 Complaints were made regarding burning of rubbish in the field by Bronydd Dwyran : Resolved to inform the enviromental dept of Anglesey County Council.
