1: APOLOGIES: Councillor Angharad Jones and Lowri Owen and O.M.Thomas.

2: DECLARATION OF INTEREST: Interest declared by Chairman Tim Owen.

3: PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES: Decision: Confirmed by Councillor Jane Roberts and seconded by Councillor David Roberts. These were accepted and signed as correct the minutes of the meeting held on 29th July 2019.

4: MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES:

4.1. Hedges and verges : All the required work has been carried out.

4.2. It was confirmed that the A4080 in Dwyranwill become a live site for the Arrive Alive speed van.

4.3. Letters were received from Martin Jones regarding the Sandman Trilathlon in Newborough it was confirmed that the organisers Aim High and Anglesey County Council were meeting to discuss this years event and it was agreed the clerk contact the council to voice the concerns raised and the council are going to pass these on to the organisers Aim High.

4.4. The clerk has received the price of the defibulator case in Dwyran which was £424.00 and a cheque was sent to the committee.

It was requested of the clerk that she write to Anglesey County Council to request that the Toilet block in Newborough be taken off the market whilst the traffic problems in Newborough are in discussion.

13. ANY OTHER MATTERS :

13.1 Concern was raised about the overgrowth of hedges by the junction of the school in Newborough and the layby by 18 /19 Ucheldre Newborough, also the willow hedge by the roundabout in Penlon Newborough is overgrown and restricting view, in Dwyran the junction of the Ink bottle cottage is overgrown and Cae Berllan est in Llangaffo there are litter problems. Agreed to inform Highways of these once again.

13.2 A request was made for the speed camera van to attend Llangaffo by the church on a more regular basis. Agreed to request this from Highways.

13.3. A letter of complaint was received regarding Fencing of livestock in Dwyran Chairman T.Owen declared an interest on this item.

13.4. Problems were reported with the gate at the school in Llangaffo and it was agreed to contact the education dept of ACC directly and a meeting will be arranged on site with the local councillor.

13.5. Problems were reported with the road surface at the junction of Bryngwyn Newborough and Frondeg Llangaffo, and the ditches from Frondeg to Ceauau Brychion need clearing. The center of the road from Cae Gors to Cefn Llanfair needs cutting as well as the hedges along this road. Agreed to write to highways to report these problems.
