13.2.It was agreed to have two dog waste bag dispensers in both Llangaffo and Dwyran, the dispensers in Newborough have been a huge success therefore it was agreed to impliment the scheme in both Dwyran and Llangaffo. It was agreed to request another waste bin for Newborough to be placed by the school.
