**4: MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES:**

**4.1** Sale of Dwyran Primary School: The chairman sent a letter to Julie James WA member outlining the lack of resources for the children of Dwyran and a meeting was held with Chief Executive of Anglesey County Council and the heads of various departments to discuss the playing field and various options were discussed.

**4.2.** Discussion is ongoing with ACC and local Llanagaffo councillors regarding Llangaffo Primary school as a similar problem is emerging regarding the school playing field. The community are trying to get a committee together to help with organising a playing field.

**9: COUNTY COUNCILLOR REPORTS :** Llanddwyn and the traffic problems were discussed situation in Newborough and outlined this was only going to get worse during the next Summer season. It was agreed to contact NRW and request another meeting to discuss this year easter / summer traffic management and the ongoing idea of a change of use of the car park /toilets area in Newborough becoming an allocated car park for the residents of Church St which would go some way to alleviate the flow of traffic on this street. There was some discussion regarding a possibility of a zebra crossing on Church St. It was confirmed that Dwyran Primary School had been sold and it was requested of the clerk enquiring with Acc who the purchaser was councillor J. Sykes commented that there were some objections about the possible new siting of the playground within the village of Dwyran.

After discussions regarding 5 possible options regarding the sale of Llangaffo Primary School playing field it was agreed that option 1 was favourable which was keeping the playing field where it situated at present and have a village committee run it. It was agreed to invite a young mother involved with the new committee to the next meeting.
