13.1 Request for bins in the playgrounds in Newborough and Llangaffo.

13.2 Numerous requests for footpaths to be trimmed back : Clerk will ask A.Thomas to attend to these as soon as possible and request that Alun Thomas cuts the grass in the playground in Llangaffo.

13.3. Various potholes were reported clerk will contact highways regarding the repairs to these.

13.4 Reports of speeding vehicles in all three villages agreed to send a stern letter to ACC and request a speed camera van attend and request something be done about the speeding tractors and use of mobile phones by the tractor drivers especially down the back lane between Llangaffo and Dwyran .

13.5 The problem with the gully in Pen Lon still has not been resolved it was agreed to write to highways and request a meeting.

13.6 There were reports of problems with traffic parking by the entrance to St Peters church will request that the yellow lines be infilled on the entrance to make it a no parking area to ensure entrance up to the church especially during funerals.

13.7 Concern was raised regarding the unfinished tarmac on the road outside Prichard Jones in Newborough agreed to enquire as to why this work has not been completed by highways.

13.8 There was a query regarding the opening of a new gate at Tal Braich Newborough will enquire with planning to see if permission for the works was required.

13.9 There were concerns regarding distances between plots in Milgwyn Councillor D.Roberts agreed to liaise with a local undertaker regarding the correct measurements between each plot.

13.10 Councillor I.Mann raised concerns regarding signage for Dwyran and suggested various options it was agreed to request better and clearer signs for the village from highways.

13.11 It was agreed to ask Alun Thomas to attend to the trees in Milgwyn as as soon as possible before bird nesting season.

13.12 There were reports of traffic speeding along the road to the beach it was agreed to let NRW know.

13.13 Queries were made as to why the children from Llangaffo and Dwyran were not able to attend the Flying Start club in Santes Dwynwen school in Newborough it was agreed to contact the school to enquire why this is and what is the catchment area is.
