13.3 40mph in Dwyran concern was raised again regarding speeding traffic Clerk will write to Highways and road traffic department of North Wales Police.

13.5 Complaints received about overnight camping and vehicles parking on verges in Llanddwyn Clerk to inform NRW regarding this.
