**3: PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES:** Mins from meetings on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2024 Confirmed by councillor Glenys Owen and seconded by councillor Jane Sykes.

**4: MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES:**

**4.1** The list of school governors of Ysgol Santes Dwynwen has been received and the number of children attending was confirmed.

**4.2** The owner of the damaged fence by the old school in Dwyran has been contacted and has agreed to the repairs.

**4.3** The overgrown hedge by Treflys in Llangaffo has been cut back.

**4.4** Anglesey County Council responded to the following concerns sent by the community council over the last few weeks : **Village signs by the bus stop in Newborough** - I was aware that there was a proposal by the Community Council to change the village name signs for more decorative ones similar to what had been installed for Aberffraw. Previous emails have made reference to this and I am aware that Councillor Arfon Wyn is going to pursue this matter and seek clarification as to the Community Councils intention **Traffic not slowing or stopping at the pedestrian crossing outside Santes Dwynwen School** This crossing point is clearly visible to approaching traffic together with any pedestrians waiting to cross. Failure to comply with the requirement to stop at the zebra crossing and give way to pedestrians is a police enforcement issue. **Speeding concerns in Newborough, Dwyran A4080 and Llangaffo** Speed surveys can be undertaken in these locations and the results sent to Go Safe. It would be up to them to determine whether any subsequent enforcement visits would be made. As the hill out of Llangaffo towards Newborough is not near to a sensitive location such as a school site then it would not be appropriate for the Authority to install traffic calming humps here. **Mirror by the Eglwys Bach Community Centre** Further consideration will be given to this request. **Parking outside Eglwys Bach Community Centre** Your comments regarding the parking situation outside the Community Centre have been forwarded to our enforcement section for action. The situation here particularly on Monday afternoons are noted and the Authority parking enforcement officers will be made aware of this.
