4: MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MONTHS MINUTES:

4.1 ACC confirmed that a work order has been issued to repair all the pot holes reported.

4.2. 2 Sisters confirmed they are looking into the problem regarding the noise at night at Morlais chicken factory in Newborough.

4.3 The recycling container at Pont Cadarch in Dwyran has been emptied and returned to site.

4.4 The street cleaning department of ACC have been in touch and they agreed to liaise with Councillor Sykes regarding identifying the litter problem areas.

4.5 ACC have posted dog bag disposal signs to put on the bins.

4.6 The problem trees in Milgwyn Cemetery have been felled.

4.7 ACC have inspected the style at Tyn Lon Newborough and confirmed there is no problem with it.

4.8 ACC confirmed there is no padlock on the gate on the public footpath behind Neuadd Wen Newborough.

4.9 It was confirmed that Mr Savage does not hold the key to the barrier by the toilets car park in Newborough the clerk will continue to enquire as to who is the key holder.

The trees in Milgwyn Cemetery have been felled due to the major problems they were causing, they had become overgrown and therefore were a danger to vehicles and pedestrians using the road alongside the cemetery and their weight had damaged the stone wall which had become unstable. The tree root system was proving problematic during buriels as the roots had grown onto the area which was required to be used and when opening the graves the roots prevented the excavater from carrying out the excavations required and therefore it was in the interest of health and safety that the trees need to be cut down.
